20 Common Traveling Phrases

Check-in:

Meaning: to register at a hotel or airport

Example: We need to check in at the hotel before 3 PM.

Exchange currency:

Meaning: to convert money from one currency to another

Example: I'll go to the bank to exchange some dollars for euros.

Board the plane:

Meaning: to get on an airplane

Example: Passengers are now invited to board the plane.

Go sightseeing:

Meaning: to visit tourist attractions

Example: Tomorrow, we'll go sightseeing in the city.

Take off:

Meaning: when a plane leaves the ground and starts flying

Example: Our flight is scheduled to take off at 9 AM.

Take a taxi:

Meaning: to hire a taxi for transportation

Example: Let's take a taxi to the airport.

Land:

Meaning: when a plane arrives at its destination

Example: We'll land in Paris in about two hours.

Get a map:

Meaning: to obtain a geographical guide

Example: It's helpful to get a map of the city.

Go through security:

Meaning: to pass through the security checkpoint.

Example: Make sure to arrive early to go through security.

Book a ticket:

Meaning: to reserve a seat for transportation

Example: I'll go online and book a train ticket.

Get a window seat:

Meaning: to choose a seat next to the window on a plane or train

Example: I prefer to get a window seat for a better view.

Go for a walk:

Meaning: to stroll or walk casually

Example: After dinner, we can go for a walk on the beach.

Get on/off the bus:

Meaning: to enter/exit a bus

Example: We need to get on the bus at the next stop.

Take pictures:

Meaning: to capture photographs

Example: I love to take pictures of interesting places.

Ask for directions:

Meaning: to request information on how to reach a place

Example: If you're lost, don't hesitate to ask for directions.

Ask for help:

Meaning: to request assistance or guidance

Example: If you're lost, don't hesitate to ask for help.

Book a hotel room:

Meaning: to reserve a room in a hotel

Example: I'll call and book a hotel room for our stay.

Get off at the next stop:

Meaning: to exit a bus, train, or subway at the upcoming station

Example: We need to get off at the next subway stop.

Check out:

Meaning: to leave a hotel after settling the bill

Example: We need to check out by noon.

Plan an itinerary:

Meaning: to create a schedule or plan for a trip

Example: Let's sit down and plan our itinerary for the weekend.
