Times of day:

- Examples: **at** 3 o' clock, **at** 10.30 am, **at** noon, **at** dinnertime, **at** bedtime
- I go to sleep **at** 10:00 p.m. / She has lunch at noon (12:00 p.m.).

Mealtimes:

- Examples: **at** lunchtime, **at** dinnertime
- She is usually home **at** dinnertime.

Expressions:

- Examples: **at** the same time, **at** present, **at** the moment, **at** night.
- We finished the test **at** the same time. / I like to read **at** night.

At

Months, years, decades:

- Examples: **in** April, 1990, **in** the 80's
- I was born **in** April , 1988. / She grew up **in** the 90's.

Seasons:

- Examples: **in** the summer, **in** the spring
- They like to visit the beach **in** the summer.

Parts of the day:

- Examples: **in** the morning, **in** the afternoon, **in** the evening
- They like to have coffee **in** the afternoon.

Specific days:

- Examples: **on** Monday, **on** Tuesday, **on** Christmas day, **on** Halloween
- I'm going to the movies **on** Sunday.

Specific dates:

- Examples: **on** November 15th, **on** December 24th
- I was born **on** April 6th.

Parts of an specific day:

- Examples: **on** Monday morning, **on** Saturday night
- I was with my mom **on** Tuesday morning.
